Financial Front

Where there is no freedom, there can be neither opportunity nor happiness. Such a disconnect between who we are as Americans and our current financial reality cannot be allowed to continue.

Therefore, Extraordinary America is about the abolition of financial slavery. It is about the financial freedom of the 99%. It is about a nation of immigrants and descendants of immigrants awakening and unleashing the extraordinary within themselves and setting themselves free.

There are three major issues confronting Americans on the financial front today.

1. Wealth and Income Inequality Between the 1% and the 99%

The first problem is the growing level of wealth and income inequality between the 1% and the 99%.

Back in 2020, the coronavirus pandemic created a massive loss of jobs, with tens of millions of people losing their incomes. Although the government temporarily offset the crisis through extensive money creation and low interest rates, another employment crisis may be on the horizon.

With current federal interest rates, combined with the rapid advancement of automation and artificial intelligence, America faces the possibility of a major recession that could result in widespread business closures and layoffs.

Even among those who currently have jobs, many are living from one paycheck to the next, trading time for money. They work in jobs they do not enjoy, and some hold

This creates significant stress, anxiety, and uncertainty about the future.

Furthermore, many Americans work within unhealthy corporate and workplace cultures where compassion is often absent. Employees are frequently treated as replaceable parts within a larger machine. They are underpaid, overworked, and easily replaced due to the abundance of labor created by globalization and outsourcing.

As a result, millions of Americans feel trapped within a system that offers little hope for long-term financial freedom.

2. Loss of Purchasing Power, Stagflation, and Debt

The second problem is the gradual reduction of purchasing power and overall wealth over time.

3. Future Recession Followed by Major Inflation or Hyperinflation

With current interest rates remaining relatively high, America may be standing at the edge of a recession. If such a recession occurs, it may be followed by another period of large-scale monetary expansion, similar to the responses implemented during the 2008 financial crisis and the 2020 pandemic.

The fundamental problems that contributed to those crises have not necessarily been solved; many have merely been postponed.

To address previous crises, governments and central banks created large amounts of fiat currency and directed liquidity into financial markets, real estate, bonds, and other assets. This contributed to the formation of what many analysts describe as asset bubbles across multiple sectors of the economy.

If these bubbles were to deflate significantly, many businesses could fail and unemployment could rise dramatically.

In response, governments and central banks may once again lower interest rates and create additional currency in an attempt to stimulate economic activity.

Such actions could result in substantial inflation, or in extreme circumstances, hyperinflation.

When new currency is created in large quantities, each existing dollar potentially loses purchasing power. The result is that the same amount of money purchases fewer goods and services than it once did.

This threatens not only incomes, but also savings, retirement funds, and long-term financial security for millions of Americans.

In the short term, we can address these problems on a personal level by investing in non-dollar-denominated assets such as precious metals and selected cryptocurrencies in order to help protect purchasing power from inflation.



In the long term, Extraordinary America proposes a three-step solution.

The Three-Step Solution

Step One: The Transformation of the 99% into Entrepreneurs and Investors

The first step is the transformation of the 99% into entrepreneurs and investors on the light side—that is, with ethics, integrity, and the goal of achieving financial freedom for all.

This transformation is to be achieved through financial literacy and education regarding money, precious metals, real estate, entrepreneurship, business creation, and investing. Extraordinary America believes that these subjects form the foundation of financial independence.

Financial literacy and education are among the foundational pillars of an economic philosophy known as Ethonomics.

Ethonomics is a new economic framework built upon science, mathematics, and ethics. It focuses on achieving success in both the short and long term while cultivating a mindset centered on abundance and prosperity rather than survival and scarcity.

The United States economy was heavily influenced by the ideas of the eighteenth-century Scottish philosopher Adam Smith, whose book *The Wealth of Nations*, published in 1776, helped establish many of the foundations of modern economic thought.

Over time, economists built upon Smith's work and helped develop the economic structures that continue to influence much of the world today. These systems emerged during periods when scarcity thinking was widespread, particularly during and after major economic crises.

The goal was to create a mixed economy—an economic system that combines elements of both capitalism and socialism. Such a system seeks to protect private property and economic freedom while allowing governments to intervene in economic activity to pursue broader social objectives.



However, by studying historical evidence and long-term patterns, Extraordinary America reaches several conclusions.

Ethonomics seeks to address these shortcomings by combining entrepreneurship, investing, ethics, and financial education into a unified framework for human upliftment.

One of the core principles of Ethonomics is the transformation of the 99% into entrepreneurs and investors with ethics. Extraordinary America believes that financial freedom can only be attained on a permanent and sustainable level when individuals acquire the knowledge necessary to create value, own productive assets, and generate wealth independently.

The best thing any individual can do is educate themselves and make the most of their potential.

For thousands of years, gold and silver served as money because societies collectively recognized them as stores of value.

However, Extraordinary America argues that what society considers valuable is not necessarily what the One Father of the Universe considers most valuable.

The Father values the upliftment of His sons and daughters above all else.

Therefore, Extraordinary America proposes that human upliftment should become the foundation of a future monetary system.

Just as gold coins were historically created through the process of mining and refining precious metals, Extraordinary America proposes the concept of "American Dream Coins" or "Human Upliftment Coins."
